Subject: Revision in the evaluation and assessment scheme for undergraduate (UG) program in light of the recently implemented National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 effective from the academic session 2023-24 and onwards

As per the guidelines laid out in the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the directives of the Gujarat Government and subsequently approval of competent authority, we are pleased to announce the implementation of a new Evaluation/Assessment Scheme for all Undergraduate (UG) program offered by our university (applicable for Non-Council Programs Run under SPU) effective from the Academic Year 2023-24 and onwards.

1. **Revised Evaluation/Assessment Scheme:** This is applicable to the students admitted in semester- 1 from Academic Year 2023-24 and onwards.

Note: Each credit carries 25 marks of which 50% marks are assigned for CCE and the rest 50% marks for SEE. The 50% marks assigned to the CCE are distributed between the continuous classroom evaluation and the mid-term evaluation.





2. Passing Criteria for Theory: (For Programs comes under UGC)

To successfully pass a course (subject), a student needs to obtain a minimum of 36% in each pattern of evaluation (Formative and Summative) components of a particular course. Absence in any of the Evaluation components of a particular course shall be considered a fail.

3. Gracing Mark:

Gracing up to a maximum of 05 marks may be awarded in aggregate of a particular course to students who have failed only in one course but passed in all other courses.

4. Rechecking and Reassessment of Answer book

Students can apply for Rechecking and Reassessment for all semester theory courses (subject) of university examination only, by paying non-refundable fees as prescribed by the university from time to time.

4.1 Re-checking of Answer book

In re-checking, only marks obtained by the student in each question and totaling of marks shall be rechecked. No assessment of the answer book will be done.

4.2 Re-Assessment of Answer book

In case of reassessment, the course (subject) answer book shall be reassessed.

- Re-Assessment Criteria

During re-assessment, if the difference between original marks and marks obtained in reassessment is 15% or more (of obtained marks), then marks of re-assessment shall be considered as final and the changes in the mark sheet will be made accordingly.

In case, the difference in the original and the re-assessment marks is less than 15% of the originally obtained marks then the reassessment marks will not be considered and the original result will stand good (rounding of the marks shall be done to the higher integer if the fraction is 0.5 and above).



5. Progression to Higher Semester - Carry Forward (Detention) Criteria

For academic progression to higher Semester, a student needs to fulfill the following criteria:

- 1) **A student can carry a maximum of Four backlogs at any point of time.**
- 2) A student having more than 04 backlogs shall not be promoted to the next Semester. S/he shall have to clear the backlogs as an ex-student. However, the backlogs in the immediate previous Semester shall not be included in the 04 backlogs.

For illustration: If a student has two backlogs in 1st Semester and three backlogs in 2nd Semester adding to a total of Five backlogs, which are more than of the maximum of Four backlogs. But this student shall be eligible to go to the 3rd Semester as the backlogs of 2nd (the immediate previous) Semester will not be considered for counting the total Four backlogs for detention. But for promotion to the 4th Semester, the student shall have to clear at least one backlog of the 1st / 2nd Semester.
