#### 1. Introduction

Examination department ensures transparency in all its activities that adequately support all students and institutions. The Examination Department administers secured processes & systems and work in close collaboration with institutions, external organizations and individuals.

During the Academic Year the Examination Section of SPU office conducted end Semester/Year Examinations as per the academic calendar of program. Academic Calendar is issued by SPU right before the commencement of academic session. Academic calendar contains key dates that are important to all students and faculty members of constituent institute which includes the start and end dates of semester, exam dates etc., Date of Examination is notified as per Academic Calendar for both odd and even semesters. A detailed Examination schedule is proposed by the concerned Dean/Principal and it is finally approved by examination section of SPU. As per teaching and examination scheme the evaluation of student's performance is completed and declared the result under the headship of Controller of Examination. SPU follows the Annual System / Semester System of examination.

#### **Annual Examination:**

With reference to the Annual academic courses, Annual Examination are conducted at the end of the Academic year. This is to review and evaluate the learning outcome of the courses and for the assessment of each student and to assess whether the student has acquired requisite knowledge and skills of the respective subject domain.

#### **Semester Examination:**

SPU follows the semester system in some courses where the academic year is divided into two terms. The end semester examination (Winter Examination & Summer Examination) is conducted by SPU.

#### Preparation of Question Paper:

Process to prepare question papers had been started two months before the commencement of Examinations. The concerned faculty dean proposed the panel of examiners by considering the Experts in the subjects and recognized as paper setters/examiners to SPU examination section and it is approved by the competent authority of SPU. The appointed paper setter upload the question paper subject wise on the portal by using login ID and password. All paper setting was made in three sets for each subject by experienced course experts from reputed college/SPU. Finally selected question paper of each subject is downloaded at the examination centre on the day of examination before 45 minutes by receiving password on registered mobile number of concerned institute. Question paper of each subject is printed & block wise packets are prepared as per requirement in the presence of Observer at the examination control room in each institute.

#### 9. Status of Automation in Examinations

The current IT integration and reforms in the examination procedures and processes have brought many significant improvements in the examination. Implementation of ERP which has helped in automating examination processes, making them more effective and efficient. Various processes, starting from the registration of students for the examination till the declaration of results are streamlined and enhanced the efficiency of examination. Automation in examinations is introduced to ensure transparency, reduction of evaluation days, speedy processing, early redressal of examination related grievances and early publication of results.

Examinations Automation solution provided by MKCL, Pune is used since May 2016 and examination activities covered in automation are summarized below:

- 1. Configuration of teaching and evaluation scheme of each course as per subject code and name.
- 2. Generation of Examination form in institute login and also in student login.
- 3. Online submission of received examination forms through digital portal of SPU by the institute.
- 4. Generation of seat number & Hall Tickets with photo & signature of student and approved by CoE and digital copies are provided through institute login and e-Suvidha application.
- 5. Examination day and subject wise attendance report (Jr. Supervisor report) generation.
- 6. On line Entry of Absent and UFM cases on the day of examination.
- 7. Examination day and subject wise Main primary barcode generation for pasting on main answer book.
- 8. Examination seating arrangement.
- 9. Invite question papers through digital portal.









- 10. Upload the subject wise final selected question paper in Secure Remote Paper Delivery system.
- 11. Suitable encryption system and secure system for the transmission of Question Papers to Examination centre at the allotted time. Password is generated through automated system and sent it to registered mobile number.
- 12. Barcode reader is used for Main barcode and examiner barcode mapping and marks data entry is completed accurately.
- 13. Capturing the internal, practical marks awarded by examiners at institute level directly to examination server.
- 14. Automatic Grade, SGPA and CGPA Calculations.
- 15. Results processing and generation of result reports.
- 16. Declaration and uploading of examination results on SPU website along with provisional copy of mark sheets for online access.
- 17. The results are also made available through e-Suvidha online portal using personal login of students.
- 18. Generation of mark sheet /grade sheet for printing. Printed mark sheet/grade sheet includes security features along with photograph, QR code and hologram.
- 19. Generation of convocation data of eligible students for award of degrees.
- 20. Application for degree certificates to be received from the eligible students for degree award.
- 21. Individual students can access the following using e-Suvidha Application
  - View and Update Profile
  - Download Examination Form
  - View and Download Examination Time-Table
  - Download Examination Hall Ticket
  - View Result of End-Semester/Year Examination
  - View Result His/Her History

Examination Automation System enables us to properly organize data of SPU and constituent colleges. Data is well managed and easily archived and retrieved.

After the admission process, each enrolled student in SPU is provided with a unique user id and password. Using this id, the student can login in to the student portal designed by SPU.





In the portal, student can view and manage their academic activities. Immediately after the admission each student is required to complete the course registration in the student portal. Continuous internal assessments and end-semester assessments are compiled through ERP. The same has resulted in improving the speed of compilation of results that are error-free. SGPA, CGPA, and results are accurately calculated. The use of stationary has largely reduced with the implementation of ERP. The efficiency of the examination department has significantly improved and reduced the manpower requirements at the same time, saving costs for SPU.

With the implementation of IT integration, the examination management system has become more accessible to students and faculty members. Students can access the system from anywhere, at any time, using their mobile devices or computers.

#### **Observations:**

It is observed that students were aware with the examination rules before appearing in the examinations. Following the key observations,

- Total number of students appeared in examinations during A.Y 2022-23 = 11314
- Average number of days from the date of last semester-end/ year- end examination till the declaration of results = 15.47
- Total 1533 students who have successfully completed all the academic requirements
  prescribed for the program are eligible for award of the degree in convocation of
  academic year and awarded degree. Also 34 students awarded Gold Medal.
- Effective IT integration in examination process, the efficiency of the examination section has significantly improved and reduced the manpower requirements.

#### Conclusion

It is recommended to reform the assessment structure for undergraduate (UG) programs offered by SPU (applicable to non-council programs under SPU) by implementing a 50% formative assessment and 50% summative assessment model, as per the guidelines of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and the directives of the Gujarat Government. This reform should be applicable to students admitted in Semester 1, effective from the Academic Year 2023-24 onwards.





Suggest to change the passing criteria as per NEP 2020 (applicable for Non-Council Program Run under SPU) as follow,

"To successfully pass a course (subject), a student needs to obtain a minimum of 36% in each pattern of evaluation (formative and Summative) component of a particular course. Absence in any of the Evaluation components of a particular course shell be considered a fail."

Assessment of B.Tech, M.tech, MBA and MCA by considering the weightage of the theory CCE (internal assessment) is 40% and for the End Semester Exam (SSE) is 60%. Further practical assessment weightage of the CCE (internal assessment) is 50% and for the End Semester Exam (SSE) is 50% and freedom should be given to faculty to design the internal assessment parameters (Focus to higher order learning).

The Teaching Scheme for semester is to be designed by considering separate Papers for the Theory Course and Practical Course having different credits and evaluation systems. The separate code for the practical course shall be considered as a new course introduced in the program from A.Y 2023-24.
