No assessment of answer book will be done.</p> <p>In case of re-assessment, the course (subject) answer book shall be reassessed.</p> <p>During re-assessment, if the difference between original marks and marks obtained in reassessment is 15% or more (of obtained marks), then marks of re-assessment shall be considered as final and the changes in the mark-sheet will be made accordingly.</p> <p>In case, the difference in the original and the re-assessment marks is less than 15% of the originally obtained marks then the reassessment marks will not be considered and the original result will stand good (rounding of the marks shall be done to the higher integer if the fraction is 0.5 and above)</p> <p>The result shall be changed only, if there is change in the result status in the course/ subject in which the student has applied for Re-assessment otherwise original result shall remain unchanged.</p> | |



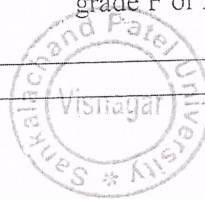



- In grading system wherein, the marks are converted to grades, and every semester results will be declared with Semester grade point average (SGPA) and Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA). The CGPA will be calculated every subsequent semester.
- A student is considered to have successfully completed a course and earned the credits if he / she secured a letter grade other than F or AB in that course. A letter grade F or AB in any course implies a failure in that course.


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Award of Class

A student should satisfy the following conditions to be eligible for award of the degree,

1. Must complete all courses as prescribed under his/her programme of studies.
2. Registered and successfully complete the courses and projects as per the curriculum.
3. Successfully acquired the required credits as specified in the curriculum corresponding to the program of his/her study within the stipulated time duration.
4. Minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 5.00
5. No "F" grade (Fail) in any subject in any of the semesters of the entire programme.
6. No disciplinary action pending against him/her.

The class awarded to a student with his/her degree will be decided by his/her final CGPA at the end of the final Semester/Year as per the following table:

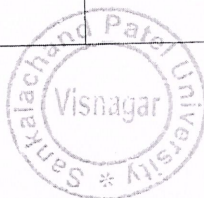


Eligibility Criteria for Award of Medal


The graduating student should satisfy the following conditions to be eligible for award of Gold Medal for scholastic performance.

1. The student should pass all the semester examinations without backlog and earn all the credits of all the courses in first attempt within the stipulated time of the program.
2. The student should secured highest Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) among eligible students with minimum CGPA being 8.00 out of 10.00.
3. In case, two or more students have secured the same CGPA then, the following criterion, in order of preference, shall be followed to decide final student for Gold Medal:
 - a) The student obtaining higher SGPA in the Final Semester shall be eligible for the award of Medal.
 - b) The student obtaining higher SGPA in the previous to Final Semester/Year shall be eligible for the award of Medal.

If condition (b) is not able to discriminate, Medals shall be given to eligible two or more students.

| Rechecking and Reassessment rules | <p>The Retotalling (Rechecking) /Revaluation (Reassessment) of answer book is allowed in only all theory subjects of University examination of MDS Part – I & Part – II, by paying non-refundable fees as prescribed by the University time to time.</p> <p>In Rechecking, only marks obtained by the student in each question and totalling of marks shall be rechecked. No assessment of answer book will be done.</p> <p>In Reassessment, the answer book of each subject shall be evaluated by other examiners as follows:</p> <p>In case of Part – I, the answer book of each subject shall be evaluated by other two examiners & average marks of two highest out of four evaluations (two new & two old) shall be computed & it shall be considered as final marks after Reassessment.</p> <p>In case of Part- II, the answer book of each subject shall be evaluated by other two examiners & average marks of four highest out of six evaluations (two new & four old) shall be computed & it shall be considered as final marks after Reassessment.</p> |
| Award of Class | <p>The class in MDS Part-I & Part- II shall be awarded on the basis of percentage as follows.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 75 % and above - Distinction ➤ 65 % to 74.99 % - First Class ➤ 50 % to 64.99 % - Second Class <p>Only those candidates who pass the whole examination in the first attempt will be eligible for award of Class.</p> <p>Mention “—” in marks sheet of repeater students in place of award of Class</p> <p>Note :- Final Degree will be awarded on the basis of the result obtained in MDS Part – II Examination.</p> |

| Answer book Evaluation | Answer Book shall be evaluated by two examiners and the average of two assessment shall be the final marks. |
| Passing Criteria | <p>Internal Assessment: It is compulsory for each student to pass with minimum fifty percent marks in the internal assessment examination prior to filling the final university examination form of the respective professional year and Head of medical institution shall send the marks of internal assessment and term test to the university prior to final examination of any professional year.</p> <p>The student who fails to complete the electives shall not be allowed to appear in annual university examination. The student shall have to secure at least 'C' grade in all the electives in order to pass the Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S) course.</p> <p>University (Assessment) Examination: The minimum marks required for passing the examination shall be fifty percent in theory component and fifty percent in practical component including practical, clinical, viva-voice, internal assessment and electives wherever applicable separately in each subject.</p> <p>Absent in any evaluation component shall be considered as Fail in a course irrespective of having good score in other components.</p> |
| Re-appear for exam | In case of fail in any component of course, student has to reappear in all the components of course in supplementary examination shall be conducted within three months of declaration of results of regular examination. |
| Permission for appear next higher examination (Academic progression rules) | For academic progression to next higher class, a student needs to fulfil the following criteria. The student shall be allowed the facility to keep term on the following conditions: |

| Grace rule | Grace marks up to a maximum of 10 marks in total may be given in End Evaluation of University Theory Examination to the students who have failed only in one or more courses. |
| Rechecking and Reassessment rules | <p>There shall be double evaluation system and shall be no provision for revaluation (reassessment) (Answer Book shall be evaluated by two examiners and the average of two assessments shall be the final marks.)</p> <p>Students can apply for Re-checking for all course (subject) in theory of university examination only, by paying non-refundable fees as prescribed by the university time to time.</p> <p>In re-checking, only marks obtained by the student in each question and totalling of marks shall be rechecked. No assessment of answer book will be done.</p> |
| Award of Class | <p>A student should satisfy the following conditions to be eligible for award of the degree,</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Must complete all courses as prescribed under his/her programme of studies.2. Registered and successfully complete the courses and projects as per the curriculum.3. No disciplinary action pending against him/her. <p>The class awarded to the student in each professional year of BHMS shall be decided as per the following table:</p> |

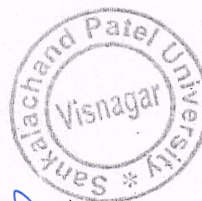




Only those students who pass the whole Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery examination in the first attempt will be eligible for award of Class.

All other successful students who passed the examination in more than first/one attempt (in supplementary examination) shall not be awarded class; irrespective of percent of marks secured.


With reference to the subject cited above, this is to inform you that various representations have been received in the commission from different universities regarding request for the guidelines for Double evaluation system in Under-Graduate examination of BHMS. In respect of the same, please find below guidelines for your reference:

- All the answer scripts shall be subjected for two valuations by the concerned University. The highest of the total marks awarded by the two evaluators for the paper, which is rounded off to the nearest value, shall be considered for computation of the results.*
- All the answer scripts, where the difference between two valuations is more than ten per cent (10%) of the total marks prescribed for the paper, may be subjected to third valuation.*
- The highest of the best two total marks, awarded by the three valuers for the paper, rounded off to the nearest value, shall be considered for final computation of the results.*
- After the computation and declaration of the results, re-valuation is not permitted by any authority under any circumstances.*

Above mentioned guidelines shall be applicable from the date of issue of this letter.

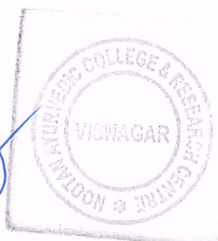

| Schedule of Examination | University Examination Conducted at the end of each professional BAMS shall be the Summative Assessment. Each professional shall be of 18 months. |
| Essentiality to appear in exam | Minimum of 75% attendance in each Subject in theory (i.e Lecture hour) and practical and Clinical (ie.Non Lecture hours) separately. |
| Scheme of Examination 1 st Prof – 1700 2 nd Prof – 2100 3 rd Prof – 2550 | The Summative Assessment will be Conducted in the form of Theory, Practical (where ever applicable) and Viva voce. Set of electives to be added. |
| Written Examination (Theory) | Theory Examination shall have 20% marks for Multiple choices Questions (MCQ) 40% Marks for short Answer Question (SAQ) and 40% Marks for Long Explanatory Answer Question (LAQ) and these questions shall cover the entire Syllabus of all Subjects. MCQ – 20 Marks SAQ – 40 Marks LAQ – 40 Marks |
| Answer book Evaluation | Answer Book shall be evaluated by two examiners and the average of two assessments shall be the final marks. (There shall not be any markings by any of the Evaluators on the answer-scripts.) |
| Double Valuation System | Principle: In the evaluation of Question –Answers of Descriptive examinations there is a possibility of variation of marks in each valuation. Double valuation offers a solution to such a situation. The acceptable limit of variation of marks between two evaluations is up to 19% of the maximum marks. After double valuation, in case of variation between both the scores are up to 19% of the total marks, Then average of both the scores will be considered as the final score. In case of fractional scores if the fraction is 0.5 or above it is rounded off to the next highest digit and if the fraction is below 0.5 it is rounded off to the lower digit value. If the difference in marks between the two evaluations is 20% or above a third valuation by another independent qualified evaluator is to be done. |
| Third Valuation | At the end of double valuation, if the variation between two independent scores is 20% and above of the maximum marks, then such scripts should be considered for third valuation. It is to be noted that at least one of the scores among two should be 35% of the maximum marks. |
| After Third Valuation | Average of the higher of two scores among all three valuations is considered as the final score. |
| Practical or Clinical Assessment | Practical or Clinical Assessment will include Marks allotted for Practical/Clinical, Viva, Electives and Internal Assessment. |

| Joining of internship | To become eligible for the Compulsory Rotatory Internship Program, all three professional examinations shall be passed and qualified in nine electives within a period of maximum ten years from the date of admission. |
| Grace rule | <p>(1) A Student may be awarded maximum ten grace marks in maximum two subjects per session with a maximum of five marks in one subject and shall be valid only for main theory examination</p> <p>(2) There shall be no provision for grace marks in any practical exam.</p> |
| Rechecking and Reassessment rules | There shall be double valuation system and shall be No Provision for revaluation. |
| Minimum Marks required for Passing | <p>A) The Minimum Marks required for Passing the examination shall be fifty percent in theory component and fifty percent in practical component (that include Clinical, practical, Viva voce, internal assessment and electives Applicable) separately in each subject.</p> <p>B) If the candidate fails in theory or practical component, he/she shall have to appear for all components of the particular subject.</p> |
| Award of Class | <p>75% and above – Distinction</p> <p>65% up to 74.99 % – First class.</p> <p>50% up to 64.99% will be declared Second class</p> <p>The award of class and distinction shall not be applicable for Supplementary examinations and such candidate shall be declared as Pass Class.</p> |
