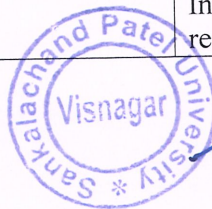


RULES FOR EXAMINATION

Evaluation Process	<p>The percentage allocation for evaluating a Theory & Practical of Course to be as given below: The weightage of the CCE (internal assessment) will be 50% and for the End Semester Exam (SEE) will be 50%. The student has to obtain at least 36 % individually in each component.</p>

Permission for appear next higher examination (Academic progression rules)	<p>For academic progression to higher Semester, a student needs to fulfil the following criteria.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A student can carry a maximum of Four backlogs at any point of time. • A student having more than 04 backlogs shall not be promoted to the next Semester. S/he shall have to clear the backlogs as ex-student. However, the backlogs in the immediate previous Semester shall not be included in the 04 backlogs. • For illustration: If a student has two backlog in 1st Semester and three backlogs in 2nd Semester adding to a total of Five backlogs, which are more than of the maximum of Four backlogs. But this student shall be eligible to go to 3rd Semester as the backlogs of 2nd (the immediate previous) Semester will not be considered four counting the total Four backlogs for detention. But for promotion to 4th Semester, the student shall have to clear at least one backlog of 1st / 2nd Semester. 								
Re-appear for exam	<p>In case of fail in any component of course, student has to reappear in that component of course in remedial examination conducted after 6 month.</p>




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
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
<p>Grace rule</p>	<p>Grace marks up to a maximum of 05 marks may be given in Semester End Evaluation of Theory Examination in a particular course to the students who have failed only in one course Semester End Evaluation of Theory Examination but passed in all other courses.</p>
<p>Rechecking and Reassessment rules</p>	<p>Students can apply for Re-checking and Re-Assessment for all semester theory course (subject) of university examination only, by paying non-refundable fees as prescribed by the university time to time.</p> <p>In re-checking, only marks obtained by the student in each question and totalling of marks shall be rechecked. No assessment of answer book will be done.</p> <p>In case of re-assessment, the course (subject) answer book shall be reassessed.</p> <p>During re-assessment, if the difference between original marks and marks obtained in reassessment is 15% or more (of obtained marks), then marks of re-assessment shall be considered as final and the changes in the mark-sheet will be made accordingly.</p> <p>In case, the difference in the original and the re-assessment marks is less than 15% of the originally obtained marks then the reassessment marks will not be considered and the original result will stand good (rounding of the marks shall be done to the higher integer if the fraction is 0.5 and above)</p> <p>The result shall be changed only, if there is change in the result status in the course/ subject in which the student has applied for Re-assessment otherwise original result shall remain unchanged.</p>

Award of Class

A student should satisfy the following conditions to be eligible for award of the degree,

1. Must complete all courses as prescribed under his/her programme of studies.
2. Registered and successfully complete the courses and projects as per the curriculum.
3. Successfully acquired the required credits as specified in the curriculum corresponding to the program of his/her study within the stipulated time duration.
4. Minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 4.00
5. No "F" grade (Fail) in any subject in any of the semesters of the entire programme.
6. No disciplinary action pending against him/her.



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The class awarded to a student with his/her degree will be decided by his/her final CGPA at the end of final Semester/Year as per the following table:

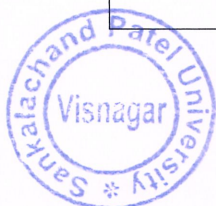
CGPA	Award of Class
7.50 and above	First Class with Distinction
6.50 to 7.49	First Class
5.50 to 6.49	Second Class
4.00 to 5.49	Pass Class

Formula for conversion of equivalent percentage of CGPA
Percentage marks = (CGPA – 0.5) *10

Eligibility Criteria for Award of Medal

The graduating student should satisfy the following conditions to be eligible for award of Gold Medal for scholastic performance.

1. The student should pass all the semester examinations without backlog and earn all the credits of all the courses in first attempt within the stipulated time of the program.
2. The student should secured highest Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) among eligible students with minimum CGPA being 8.00 out of 10.00.
3. In case, two or more students have secured the same CGPA then, the following criterion, in order of preference, shall be followed to decide final student for Gold Medal:
 - a) The student obtaining higher SGPA in the Final Semester shall be eligible for the award of Medal.
 - b) The student obtaining higher SGPA in the previous to Final Semester/Year shall be eligible for the award of Medal.If condition (b) is not able to discriminate, Medals shall be given to eligible two or more students.
4. In case of subject specialization of any program, Gold medal shall be awarded subject to minimum 10 students appeared in final Semester examination of the subject specialization.
5. For Award of Gold Medal in any Program, atleast 50% students of approved intake of Program must have appeared in Final Year examination.
6. Students who have been detained, remain absent, failed, taken semester gap, could not complete semester shall not be considered for the Award of Medal.



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
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
